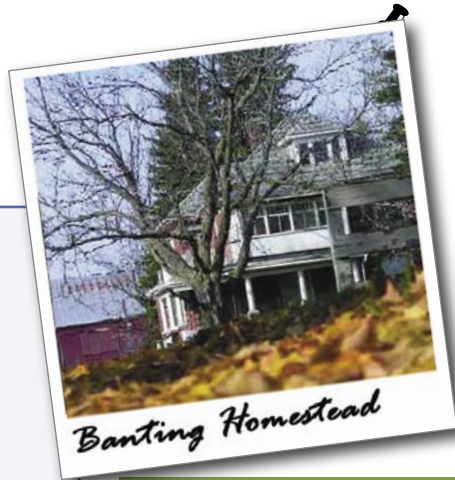

One of four communities forming the new municipality of The Town of New Tecumseth, Alliston is graced with the meandering Nottawasaga River, magnificent scenery and an extensive history. New Tecumseth is structured for development yet still retains it's rural, small town charm.
