Known as the land of shining waters - this is a welcoming and peaceful area also alive with the vibrancy and charm of small town Ontario. It's history, culture and interest today is rooted in the establishment of the Trent Severn Waterway that charts a course through the Kawarthas from one famed lift lock in Peterborough to another in Kirkfield. Only 1 - 2 hours from Toronto, this region offers students lakes for water recreation, trails for biking, hiking and cross-country skiing.

The village of Fenelon Falls is one of seventeen communities that make up the larger municipality of the City of Kawartha Lakes. With over 250 lakes and rivers throughout vast stretches of panoramic beauty, Fenelon Falls and the Kawartha Lakes area is a year-round destination for outdoor adventure seekers. As you walk through the streets of Fenelon Falls, you will find wonderful antique shops, a variety of restaurants & coffee houses, beautiful flower shops and trendy clothing boutiques.
