- Located on the Trent Severn Waterway & Scugog River
- Population: City of Kawartha Lakes: approx. 73,215 (Lindsay: 20,350 // Fenelon Falls: 1,800)
- 120-145 km north east of Toronto; 40 km west of Peterborough

Notable features:

- 2001, both towns became part of the larger City of Kawartha Lakes
- Warm, humid summers and cool brisk winters are typical
- Part of the Trent-Severn Waterway, a canal system that links Central Ontario with Lakes Ontario and Huron
- In 2007, Lindsay celebrated its 150th anniversary
- Primary industries include agriculture and tourism
- The Kawartha Dairy is well-known as the "best ice-cream" in Ontario
