Midland has a dynamic waterfront, which includes the picturesque Harbour and the newly completed waterfront trail for walking, biking and rollerblading. Penetanguishene is an historic, bilingual (French / English) community first recognized in 1793 with the establishment of a naval base. Both communities are in close proximity to ski & snowboard facilities and offer students the opportunity to explore some of the beautiful nature the area offers through the Wye Marsh Wildlife Centre as well as come to know the history of European and Native American relations.
